Dear Parent/Carers.

Last week, saw the **end of this season's examination series**. Over the last few weeks, 8079 separate exam papers have been sat at Ilkley Grammar School involving 89 individual GCSE and level 1/2 technical examinations and 94 AS and A-Level exams. These numbers reflect the scale of the operation, and I would like to take the opportunity to thank Jan Stewart, our Exams Manager, the exams team and everyone who has supported to make the series run incredibly smoothly. It is a very pressurised situation running an exams series on a large, complex site, whilst the school is in full operation and when the stakes are so high for young people and the impact of calm leadership, detailed planning and a student and solution focussed approach cannot be underestimated. A huge well done to the team but also to the students who have been a credit to the school and also deserve praise for their conduct, hard-work and resilience.

Over the past week, The Lexus Ilkley Trophy, a world-class tennis tournament, has been held on the grass courts at the Ilkley Lawn Tennis and Squash Club. It features both the ATP Challenger and ITF women's events and is considered one of the highlights of the summer grass court season. We are delighted to be able to support such a prestigious event with 86 IGS students being given the opportunity to be a member of the ball crew. They represented themselves and the school brilliantly and we are really proud of their commitment, resilience and the hours they have invested in supporting one of the biggest local events of the year. A huge well done and thank you to all of the crew and thank you to the tennis club for giving them the opportunity.

Today, our year 7-10 boys' tennis team depart for Nottingham University for the **LTA** national final of the Glanville Cup. This is a phenomenal achievement in itself having beaten 4 independent schools in their path to the final and securing a guaranteed place in the top 16 in a national under-18 competition. We wish the boys the very best of luck and we hope they enjoy their experience across the 4 days of competition.

IGS came away with a 6-0 victory.




A huge well done to all the students who represented IGS as a ball crew member at Ilkley Lawn Tennis and Squash Club


SPARX MATHS SUCCESS!

Earlier this year, we changed the homework platform used by students every week in Maths. As we now near the end of term, it is clear to see the incredibly positive impact that this change is having on our students. Sparx Maths, the new online platform, provides students with a completely personalised homework experience. It learns more about our students every week and, as time passes, the algorithm in the background works to tailor learning to suit the needs and confidence of each student.

Sparx Maths has been backed by lots of research over a number of years, with clear evidence that it improves students' confidence in mathematics as well as just their results. Over the last few months, we have successfully introduced and embedded Sparx Maths as part of the weekly routine for every student in Years 7 - 9. We have seen 207,948 questions correctly answered by our students in total, with 4415 hours of personalised practice completed on the Sparx Maths platform.

Since we moved onto Sparx Maths, we have seen a 447% increase in the average number of questions that students are answering correctly, with students correctly answering an average of 161 more questions on Sparx Maths compared to this same time period last year.

Special mention needs to go to the students who have collected the highest number of XP points on the Sparx Maths platform for their respective year groups. A massive well done to Tom Moffatt (7IFL), Jasmine Bearpark (7SP), Patrick Ke (8PC), Elsa Isherwood (8JCK), Sam Bryson (9JPM) and Isabelle Atkinson (9CPM)!
