Dear all,

Thank you for all your help on Saturday. We had a great day, we hope you did too, we know the families did!

We love organising days out like this for families supported by Refugee Action, we know the difference having something to look forward to can have for a family. Having organised days out like this for approx. 5 years we have met some families fairly regularly, others are new to us each time we have a day out, but at every day out we welcome people who might be apprehensive about what is in store for them and without exception at the end of the day families leave with a huge smile and a sense that they have all had a good day out. The parents have had a day of not having to think about how to feed their children and what do that day and the children have something to go into school (assuming they have a school place) and talk about with their friends.

YOU helped make that happen on Saturday. YOUR being there made the difference to the families on Saturday, whether you donated or sorted the bedding out in the morning and generally helped us set up, bagged the bedding with the families as they arrived, served them drinks and organised the food all day, made food but were not present on the day, took them out on the Moors for the orienteering, helped them create something really beautiful in either of the Art Rooms, chatted to them and helped us clear up at the end of the day we thank you for the time you took out of your busy schedules to make this happen for them.













We welcomed 60 people living in Bradford (from countries such as Nigeria, Sudan, El Salvador, Iran and Iranian Kurdistan) we were a group of 85 enjoying a day together. That is HUGE, particularly in the political climate at the moment where it is more important than ever to extend the hand of friendship and show people they are welcome.

A number of the Iranian families made the mobiles and left them to be displayed in school. The reason they left their artwork behind is to educate others about what is happening in Iran. What a powerful piece of art to have hanging in IGS, it is thanks to you for welcoming them that they felt safe enough to speak about what is happening in their home country and share it with you and others.

One of the most powerful quotes we have ever received from a lady taking part in one of our days out has stayed with me. She said: 'Thank you for making me feel like a human being again'.

Thank you for your help on Saturday, for providing fun for the families and making them feel welcome.
