Pathways

- 3 A Levels + Enrichment This allows you to focus on 3 core subjects and add to your CV and make you stand out from other candidates.
- **BTEC, A Level + Enrichment** Best suited to those with an average of grade 5 at GCSE and regular coursework assessment rather than a final exam at the end of 2 years.
- 4 A Level subjects This is only recommended for students averaging around a grade 7 at GCSE and considering a highly competitive degree course / university or Blue Chip company apprenticeship.
- **3** A Levels subjects + 1 AS An AS grade at the end of Y12 will allow you to put a grade on your competitive apprenticeship application form or on your university (UCAS) application form to show your Level 3 achievement.







Important Point:

During the first 2 weeks you may swap subjects if you realise that you've made a mistake, providing the group size is acceptable.

After this point, you must stick with your options through the year. There is not an option to drop subjects mid-year.


Tasks to complete







Post-16 Bursary - Application Process

The 16-19 Bursary is available to all Post 16 students meeting the criteria as defined on the website.

Payments are made by BACS transfer at the end of each half term providing the conditions listed below have been met.

Application forms and details of the entry criteria will be available in September from the Post 16 office and all applications must be submitted before October.

Conditions:

- All registration periods are attended
- All timetabled lessons and study periods are attended. If on an open day a green form must be signed/authorised to enable payment
- Attendance must not fall below 95%
- No deadline/homework concerns

Students use iPads/laptops in all lessons and lessons are planned accordingly


