In 2019, almost 80% progressed to university, with a further 5% deferring entry for 2020. 6 students secured university places at Oxford or Cambridge. Other students have successfully gone on to apprenticeships, employment or further training.

- In 2018/19 90% of IGS Post-16 students continued their studies in Higher Education
- An average of 55% of students over the last 3 years have obtained places at Russell Group Universities
- The Apply + group supports applications to Oxbridge or medicine-based courses.
- Over the last 3 years 17 students have progressed to Oxbridge.
