The Challenge:

Transferring from primary to secondary school is a major event in any student's life, but there are many things that schools can do to make this process a positive and stress-free experience.

The key to successful transition for all students is linked to their ability to develop good relationships with staff and their peers.





There are five indicators of a successful transition system students:

- 1. Develop new friendships and improve their self-esteem and confidence.
- 2. Settle in so well that they cause no concerns to their parents.
- 3. Show an increased interest in school and schoolwork.
- 4. Get used to their new routines and school organisation with ease.
- 5. Experience curriculum continuity and avoid any learning dip.


