FLASS is committed to the welfare of both its service users and staff. We offer a range of services to employers, including supporting individuals who want to become an apprentice. We aim to support and develop positive relationships, be these between parents, carers and children or schools/centres and the families they serve.

The courses and programmes we offer are funded through the Education Skills Funding Agency and all community learning provision including family learning is funded by the Adult Education Budget.

Every year many adults join us at FLASS to start or continue their learning. Some adults want to learn new skills to get a job or support their children's learning whilst some want to gain a new qualification to help them obtain a job, progress in their work or make a change in their career. Some learners want to improve reading, writing, speaking, math's or computer skills because not having these skills is causing them challenges in the job market and in their everyday lives.

On completion of this course learners can progress to a recognised qualification Child's Learning & Development. This has supported parents to be successful and secure employment as teaching assistants in schools.



All parents will be contacted to complete an initial assessment and diagnostic to establish their start point and current level. Over the past 15 months we have identified that placing parents in groups at the same level has enabled learners to progress quicker, feel more confident and feel their skills have been stretched and challenged.

If parents, choose to opt for the blended approach to remote learning rather than face to face delivery there will be fast track delivery available to suitable learner's dependent on their commitment and ability.

All your parents will be fully supported through our digital access workshop to get up and running with the remote learning platform. All learners require is a smart phone or device that has connectivity to the internet.

We do appreciate that some parents are digitally excluded and have language barriers and face to face delivery is available in our training centre and locally in libraries and in schools if permitted as restrictions are eased.


