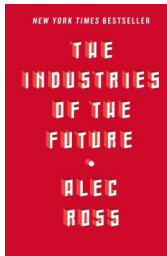
**Life 3.0: Being Human in the Age of Artificial Intelligence – Max Tegmark**

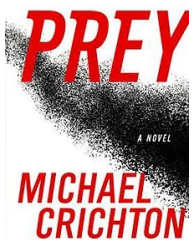
**I, Robot— Isaac Asimov**
