Communication and relationships have become an increasing focus of attention in debates about the future of health and social care. People working in care services are being encouraged to improve communication processes.



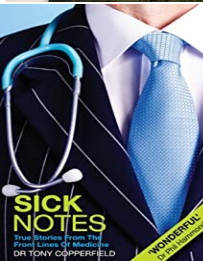
Health and Safety Executive – Essentials of Health and Safety at Work (HSE Books, 2006)
